Why did you create the BRS Shipbrokers Graduate Program?

The profession of shipbroking is exciting and requires many skills that are not necessarily taught in schools and universities. We created this program 9 years ago to allow young people to acquire the codes that will, in return, allow them to become shipbrokers within the company.

The BRS Shipbrokers' Graduate Program is a great way to attract new talents by giving an opportunity to learn and develop their skills through their presence and shadowing next to our physical position on Shipbrokers desks.

By deciding to invest in the development of new hires and having them rotating in various locations and departments, BRS can identify, value, support and develop those with the potential to efficiently join the shipbroking teams and take on more senior roles in the future within the organization.

What is the background of the candidates you choose?

The common points between all the selected candidates are: a passion for shipping, an international profile and very high motivation.

Our program is designed to attract a diverse range of candidates, both women and men, and to promote inclusivity within the company. By providing opportunities to individuals from different backgrounds, the company benefits from a wider range of perspectives and ideas.

What career prospects at BRS can a young person who participates in the program expect?

At the end of the 12 months program and provided our original expectations are confirmed, we offer a permanent position to the new hire within one of the BRS offices and departments. It is obvious that, prior such offer, a preliminary exchange takes place with the candidate to consider their own preference.

A few years later, and by decision of the Board, most of our successful Shipbrokers are invited to join the Company's partnership after having proved their qualifications and personal involvement.
